Theresa Hoover graduated from Philander Smith College in Little Rock Arkansas and soon after leaving her first job working for the Urban League, she went to work for the Woman's Division of the General Board of Global Ministries of the United Methodist Church.

Her responsibilities as a field worker took her to mission sites throughout the United States and several foreign countries. Eventually she rose to the highest office in the Woman's Division as its director..

Her honors were numerous including the "Community and Global Citizen Award" given as a grant annually a young woman who provides service, is concerned and responsible in today's world. Upon retirement Theresa came to live in her home town of Fayetteville, Arkansas.
