

# **DR. HERBERT L. BOYER**

## **1886-1976**

**In many ways Dr. Boyer's life was the life of the typical Arkansas Country Doctor. His grandfather had been a medical corpsman during the Civil War and had died while nursing a smallpox patient. A graduate of the University of Arkansas medical school in 1911, he returned to Johnson County, Arkansas where he had taught school for one year before going into medical school. He practiced medicine for 18 years.**

**In 1929 he moved to Choctaw County, Oklahoma to continue his medical practice. After seventeen years in Oklahoma he moved back to Arkansas to take over the Lincoln Clinic.**

**Moving back to Arkansas was a dream come true for Dr. Boyer. He would remain in Washington County for the rest of his life.**
