

## THE DR. T. E. RHINE PARK – a Calhoun County Park

A meeting was held Thursday for the Dr. T. E. Rhine Park Project to find ways to raise funds to buy the land and to also preserve the Rhine historical legacy.

It was decided at that meeting that:

- The two main goals were the preservation of the historical legacy of Dr. T. E. Rhine as well as the establishment of the county park.
- Plans on how to raise money for those goals were made by Trailrider groups and by former Rhine hunt club members.
- The parks ownership will be Calhoun County and governed by a DR RHINE Park Board.
- Fencing will be installed to control and eliminate access by drug dealers and dumpers.
- Cleanup and maintenance will be by county and volunteers.
- Grants by the county for improvements can be made after a deed is obtained.
- Area folks are soliciting donations for the Dr. T. E. Rhine Park.
- The Trailrider groups are forming plans on a TRAILRIDE to raise funds for the park.

Time is short due to the Deltic Timber deadline and we hope to show progress on the project and donations in the next week. *Sept. 15 - AT THE LATEST.*

It was known that a negative petition was also circulated. It was based on a story that the park would continue as it is currently – as a dump and drug deal spot without access control. The meeting attendees will spread the information as above to make area folks aware of the actual plans. Part of the negative petition was based on complaints of lack of law enforcement presence and on bad roads – and these items are not relevant to Dr. Rhine or the park project. The park project should not be linked to these old and ongoing complaints.
